2:16 **PRESENTATION – STATE REPRESENTATIVE MARC GRAVITT HONORING PAM HURST, REGISTER OF DEEDS**

State Representative Marc Gravitt presented House Joint Resolution No. 977 commending Pam Hurst, who is retiring September 1, 2018, for her honorable 24 years of service as Hamilton County Register of Deeds. He stated since her election in 1994, Mrs. Hurst has helped develop the Hamilton County Register's Training and Document Guide, which is used by staff and legal entities for document filing guidelines; she also wrote and continues to update the Tennessee Register's Guidebook with new legal information and procedures. He reported under Mrs. Hurst's leadership, the office began the electronic filing of documents in 2006 and she has provided an on-site Spanish course for all employees.

Representative Gravitt spoke about the many awards Mrs. Hurst has received throughout her years of service, including being named 2012 County Official of the Year by the County Officials Association of Tennessee, the 2002 Register of the Year by the

He reminded Commissioners about the change to the program's pay structure (*Resolution No. 218-13*), which increased the base salary of full-time judicial commissioners to \$80,000.00 per year; with an additional \$4,000.00 increase each new term until the base is \$92,000.00 per year.
