Total present – 9. Total absent -0.

Also in attendance were County Mayor Jim Coppinger, members of his administrative staff, Assistant County Attorney Neill Southerland, and County Auditor Jenneth Randall.

0:41 Commissioner Graham introduced Pastor James P. Rushing, Temple Baptist Church, who gave the invocation. Commissioner Graham noted today is Flag Day. He gave a brief history of the day, which represents a June 14, 1777 decision by the
