Notice rules regarding Disabled, Senior, Military and Resident Rates

- *Citizens qualifying for ANY courtesy discount must occupy the rented site each night.
- *Citizens qualifying for ANY discount must show proof of qualification at time of check in.
- *Seniors must show proof of age being 65 years of age or older and occupy site each night.
- *Hamilton County Resident Rate: Must show proof of residence and stay on site each night.
- *For Active Military: Current US Military ID Card or leave papers are required upon check-in at the park
- *For Veteran: ID card or copy of form DD-214
- *The ADA disability discount is available upon showing satisfactory proof of eligibility. Unless obvious to the observer, satisfactory proof includes a letter or certificate from social security or the Veterans Administration or Certification by a physician licensed in Tennessee, a distinct license plate or placard.

CAMPGROUND RULES AND REGULATION

- **REFUNDS:** Refunds for cancellations, rescheduling or any changes, must be done no later than seven (7) business days **before** your reservation.
- **CAMPSITE RENTALS:** The individual renting the campsite must be the individual occupying the campsite. Non-reservable site rentals are on a first come, first-served basis after registering at Ranger Station. Camper is not required to bring RV/tent to register. You must stop and register at the Ranger Station before you park or set up on any campsite. Your site is not secured until you have registered or reserved and paid for your site number, including when you are transferring to another site. **Stabilizers and jacks must have wooden blocks under each when parked on asphalt sites.**
- **CAMPSITE TRANSFERS :** Campsite Transfers are subject to one transfer per day, per customer.
- **RENEWALS:** All patrons that wish to renew their campsite must do so before noon on their designated check out day.
- **CHECK OUT TIME:** 12pm (Noon) (No late check-out. If you have not checked out by noon, you will be charged an additional day.)
- **CAMPING TAGS:** **Please drop your tag in the mailbox provided when checking out.** Drop box is for Park Employees only and shall not be tampered with including removal of contents.
- **QUIET HOURS:** 10pm to 6am. No loud music, loud talking or bright lights are permitted. All children under 18yrs must be on their site by 10pm
- **CAMPSITES:** Each site may contain no more than 8 people. A campsite may contain only one approved camping unit. This site may also contain one tent but no more than three tents. All parked vehicles must not infringe on a neighboring campsite or block the road in any way. Camping is not allowed on spaces between numbered sites.
- **LENGTH OF STAY:** Camping on waterfront sites is limited to 14 consecutive days of the 28 day limit in the park. You must vacate any waterfront site for at least 7 days before becoming eligible to return to a waterfront site. After staying a maximum of 28 days in the park you must vacate the campground for 7

consecutive days before becoming eligible to camp again. This applies to the individual and the camping unit. An exception to the 28 days in the park may be made by the Director of Parks and Recreation between the months of November and March.

- **LAUNDRY FACILITIES:** Open 24 hours. Please do not leave clothes in the machines unattended. No clothes lines.
- **WATER AND ELECTRICAL HOOK-UPS:** Rewiring of electrical hook-ups is strictly prohibited. During freezing temperatures, disconnect water hoses when not in use.
- **DUMP STATIONS:** The dumping of gray or black water is allowed only at the designated dump stations provided in the park.
- **AGE REQUIREMENT:** Campsite may only be rented to someone 18 years of age or older. Any camper under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult during their stay.
- **CAMPFIRES:** Campfires are only allowed in the provided fire ring or by using a self-contained unit that is at least 6 inches off the ground. No unattended fires are allowed.
- **PARKING:** Camping or parking between sites is not allowed nor is blocking the road in any way. All vehicles must remain on prepared surfaces at all times. No parking in the grass or in empty campsites. There is a 2 vehicle maximum at each site. Overflow parking is available throughout the campground.
- **INTOXICANTS:** Alcoholic Beverages are prohibited. State Law prohibits the possession or use of illicit drugs in the Park. Violators may be prosecuted.
- **TRANSPORTATION:** All park patrons are required to have motorized transportation throughout the course of their stay. No unlicensed or unregistered motorized transportation is allowed. All motorized transportation and operators must conform to state laws.
- **WEAPONS:** Bows and arrows, explosives, fireworks, slingshots, fishing spears, or any device that discharges projectiles by any means is prohibited. Firearms are prohibited unless a person possesses a valid weapons-carry license for a firearm that is valid in the State of Tennessee. Persons with such licenses may carry a firearm except where prohibited by state or federal law.
- **PETS:** Pets are welcome everywhere except the Beach. Pets must be leashed (no longer than 6 feet) and accompanied by the owner at all times. If a pet demonstrates aggressive behavior toward another pet or camper, you will be asked to leave the campground. No excessive barking. Owners must clean up after their pets.
- **COLLECTING:** Removal or destruction of wildlife, plant life, or shore line rock is prohibited.
- **TRASH:** Trash is picked up daily. Camper should use the trash receptacles provided and keep their campsites in a neat and orderly fashion.
- **BE COURTEOUS AND RESPECTFUL:** Please follow only designated roads or walkways. Do not cut through occupied campsites.

Amenities: 50/30 amp breaker service for all electrical sites/ 50 amp breakers and receptacles are 240 volt/ 20 and 30 amp breakers and receptacles are 110 volt. Dump stations (See Campground Map). Laundry facilities. Showers /restrooms. Boat ramp. Fishing piers. Playgrounds. WiFi.

Swimming area at the beach: No lifeguard on duty. Swim at your own risk.

Volleyball equipment on loan (must leave Drivers License until equipment is returned.)
