No outside grills, fryers, or smokers are allowed to be setup on or near Shelters.

Must leave premises in pre-event condition

Park Rules:

Pets allowed on a leash - please clean-up after your pets.

No swimming

No camping

No open fires

No alcoholic beverages or other intoxicants

Bows and arrows, explosives, fireworks, slingshots, fishing spears, or any device that discharges projectiles by any means is prohibited. Firearms are prohibited unless a person possesses a valid weapons-carry license for a firearm that is valid in the State of Tennessee. Persons with such licenses may carry a firearm except where prohibited by state or federal law.

No loitering around parked vehicles or in parking lots

Park closes at sunset in designated areas

No motorized vehicles on trails (except wheelchairs)

Roller blade users and bicyclists will use extreme caution and proceed at reduced speeds on trails.
